AGM 2021 – Annual Registrar Report

Richmond Jets Minor Hockey AGM – June 1st, 2021

2020/2021 Season Summary:

This was a season like no other. The 2019/2020 season came to an abrupt end when the pandemic took hold. The entire 2020/2021 season was dictated by Covid-19, the PHO and the restrictions imposed upon us. This season saw 801 players registered for programs on a total of 51 teams.

As you can see by numbers, we were down in registration numbers from the previous year. We had a significant number more registered at the beginning of the season but due to covid some families chose to withdraw. We also had 70 plus participants move to other programs such as Zone teams, Hockey Academies, Junior leagues and other unsanctioned organizations.

The Jets hosted another successful, fully enrolled First Shift program this season. As this session was offered in the second half of the year, we were not able to move the participants into a Jets program the same season, usually referred to as Second Shift, but we are seeing many of them register for the 2021-2022.
